Kyana’s new-to-her Malibu will afford her the transportation needed to fulfill all of her personal commitments, report to Reserve duty, and earn her pharmacy degrees: associate’s, bachelor’s and finally doctorate.

She was referred through the joint efforts of Mark Elliott, Hillsborough Community College Benefit Advisor and three Veterans’ Administration professionals: Jane Spencer, Carol Griffiths, and Dan Wilder – all of whom are partnering for an expansion of Vehicles for Veterans in 2010.
